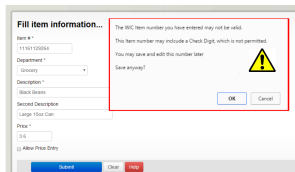


Your MobiWIC Newsletter - May 2016



Your MobiWIC website just got smarter! Tired of "guessing" if your new WIC Item Number is the correct one? Your MobiWIC website will now tell you if your newly entered Item Number is correct immediately after you enter it! Just add the WIC Item Number to your website, then click SUBMIT. MobiWIC will then check and verify that your Item Number is valid!



MobiWIC will now notify you if you have already saved an incorrect WIC Item. Just look for a **RED** WIC Item number in your Item List (see below)!

The way in which you sell WIC Produce is changing.

The State of Ohio will no longer list canned/package Produce on the Approved Product List.

BEGINNING JUNE 1, 2016

You will no longer be able to scan and sell WIC Produce using the UPC (bar-code) on the packaged Item. Beginning June 1, 2016 you must sell these Items by manually entering the item Price Look Up ("PLU") codes. You may locate the PLU code for any item on the OH WIC Approved Product List.

For Example

Currently:

To sell a can of Grapefruit Segments, you may scan the the UPC (bar-code) from the can, or manually enter that number in to your MobiWIC terminal.



As of June 1, 2016:

The bar-code from these items will no longer be valid. You will use the Item "Price Look Up" code ("PLU") from the Ohio WIC Approved Product List. You will use this number and manually enter it in place of the previously used scanned UPC bar-code from the package.

In this example, you would instead use this WIC Item Number:

WIC UPC/PLU Report

000	10000000000033602	GRAPES
000	10000000000000000	GRAPEFRUIT

You may locate WIC Item PLU codes on the Ohio Approved Product List (APL). You should always consult the OH WIC Authorize Foods List
